## ANATOMICAL TERMINOLOGY

Some basic biological terminology should be studied at this time. Familiarize yourself with the following words and learn to use them in referring to the location of the body parts of your specimen.

## **Directions or Positions**

Anterior (Cranial)
Posterior (Caudal)
Dorsal (Superior)
Ventral (Inferior)

Lateral Medial

Proximal Distal toward the headtoward the tail

toward the backbonetoward the belly

toward the bellytoward the side

toward the midline

— lying near the point of reference

stal — lying further from the point of reference Note: The terms in parentheses are synonymous only when referring to a quadruped such as a pig.

In man these terms have different meanings (see diagrams at the end of this section).

## Planes or Sections Through the Body

Transverse (Cross Section)

Sagittal

Frontal (Coronal)

- perpendicular to the long axis of the body
- a longitudinal section separating the body into right and left sides
- a longitudinal section dividing the specimen into dorsal and ventral parts
